

Installing the TV App

From the menu, you will need to download the newest version of SFNTVNOW Gen 2. (Be sure to type sfntvnow as one word when searching). During this process, you will be prompted to enter your Username and Password. If you need this information, please give us a call at 540.745.2111 or 276.637.6485. You will also be prompted to Name the Device you are downloading the app onto.

Beginning View of the Home Screen

(You will need a unique name per device.)




Type sfntvnow with the remote keyboard



Press **GET** to install the app



Arrow left and select Search



Select the royal blue SFN TV Now Gen2 app (Do NOT select the demo version)



Once installed, select Open App

Installing the TV App Continued...

You will need to enter the same SFN credentials you had before (usernames are typically first initial & last name with no spaces and all lowercase) You will also have to choose your **Device Name** (NOTE: You will need a unique name per device). These names can be whatever you want (bedroom, living room, office, etc)

EXAMPLE LOGIN:

Subscriber Name: jdoe Password: ###### Device Name: office


Getting Started with the Remote Control Main Features

Main Menu

In a few moments, you will see the first live TV channel in the lineup with the main Menu as shown below.



NOTE: Once the new SFN TV Now Gen 2 app is successfully installed, we recommend at some point uninstalling your previous SFN TV Now app.

Introduction to Your TV Features


Here are some of the main features available to you.

- Record what you are watching live, record a program or series from the TV Guide that aired up to 24 hours ago, and schedule future recordings from the TV Guide
- From the main TV Menu, see the weather in your area, view a list of programs on each channel available for restart, and go to Settings for creating favorite lists and parental controls
- Go back up to 24 hours in your TV Guide to watch or record a program or add it to your favorite list

TV Guide

Two Guide views are available. The left grid style is the default view, but you can choose the right view in Settings / Advanced / Guide Type.






The Left Grid Guide version has the live TV channel in the upper right corner, where you can pause the video.

The Right Grid Guide version has no live TV view, but you have bigger channel logos and fonts.

Advanced Settings to Change TV Guide View





From the Settings menu, select "Advanced" then choose "Guide Type". "Classic" is the default grid style guide, and "New" has the larger fonts and channel logos.

Here are the options for programs airing in the future.





Restart TV that You Missed

You can scroll back up to 24 hours in the TV Guide to watch or record a program you may have missed. The main Menu also has a "Restart TV" list of all the programs available to restart in the past 24 hours listed by channel number.

Program Options While Watching TV

While watching a program (live or replay), press the remote center "OK" button to display all your options.



Use your remote pause, rewind, fast forward buttons, or use the on-screen icons 123 displays a numeric keypad to enter the CH #

- CC Closed Captioning, quick press to turn on/off, long press to choose different font size





How to Record

- 1. You can record the program you are watching live when you press the remote center circle button during a live program. You then can select the record option (you can record one episode or a series).
- 2. From the TV Guide, you can schedule to record a future program or go back in the TV Guide up to 24 hours to watch or record a program. **NOTE: Recordings are auto-deleted in 7 days.**




Create Favorite Channel Lists

One new feature of SFN TV Now is that you can now create as many favorite channel lists as you want. For example, you could create lists in your Settings like SPORTS, MOVIES, NEWS or you may want to create lists for members of your family (MOM, DAD, GRANDPA, ETC..)



How to See Your Favorite Lists


Choose between seeing all channels and your favorite lists from the vertical channel list. When watching live programming, press the remote left arrow to display all channels, then you can press the remote right arrow to toggle through your favorite lists.

Changing Your Favorite Lists

REMOVING CHANNELS FROM YOUR FAVORITES: When viewing a favorite channel list in the vertical Guide, press and hold the center circle remote button to display the below screen. Here, you can remove this channel from your favorite list.



ADDING CHANNELS TO YOUR FAVORITES: When viewing all channels in the vertical Guide, press and hold the center circle remote button to display the below screen. Here, you can add this channel to a favorite list.
